RIVER FEALGE (CLONAKILTY) CERTIFIED DRAINAGE SCHEME
IN THE COUNTY OF CORK

TO ALL WHOM IT MAY CONCERN:

Notice is hereby given, pursuant to Section 5 of the Arterial Drainage Act, 1945 and Section 5 of the Arterial Drainage (Amendment) Act, 1995, that we the Commissioners of Public Works in Ireland, being of the opinion that the execution of drainage works is expedient in respect of a part of the River Fealge, Clonakilty, Co. Cork and its tributaries for the purpose of preventing or substantially reducing the periodical localised flooding of lands in the area of that watercourse, have pursuant to Section 4 of that 1945 Act, as amended, prepared a Drainage Scheme for the said area.

A copy of the scheme will be available for inspection by any person claiming to be interested therein from Monday, 15th December, 2014 to Tuesday, 20th January, 2015 both dates inclusive at the following locations:

- **O' Donovan's Hotel, Pearse Street, Clonakilty, Co Cork (from 14.00 to 20.00 on 15th December)**
- **Clonakilty Town Library, Kent Street, Clonakilty, Co Cork (from 16th December during normal opening hours)**

The scheme drawings are accompanied by an Environmental Impact Statement and Non-Technical Summary, which will be available for sale from the Office of Public Works, Jonathan Swift Street, Trim, Co. Meath at a cost of €40 and €5 respectively. CD versions of the full Environmental Statement will also be available for €5.
